

2016 – 2017 Home School Program at Charlie Elliott Wildlife Center

We are happy to continue our monthly home school program this school year! The center's forests, lakes, and streams provide an excellent setting for outdoor learning. The indoor classrooms and live animals enhance the experience by providing up-close wildlife encounters.

The drop-off program is designed for the home-schooled student, emphasizing peer cooperation along with individual exploration. Each program covers a different topic, but all programs include hands-on learning, self-discovery, and outdoor fun. Through hikes, experiments, games, and investigation, we will uncover the secrets of Georgia's wildlife and habitats.

Age and Group Size: The program is designed for $3^{rd} - 7^{th}$ grade students. The students sometimes will be divided into two age groups, $3-4^{th}$ grade and $5^{th} - 7^{th}$.

Time: 9:30am – 1:30 pm (Students bring their own lunch.)

Location: Charlie Elliott Wildlife Center's Brooke Ager Discovery Area

Cost: \$70 per student for the academic year

Dates: The program takes place the 3rd Friday of each month from October to April
