

Required GOSP Protective Language

Acquisitions Only

Real property or conservation easements acquired with GOSP funds shall remain protected as conservation lands into **perpetuity**.

Grantees are required to record a final deed with the local government having jurisdiction containing the GADNR required Protective Language:

“The Property was acquired in part using grant funds provided to “the Grantee” by the Georgia Department of Natural Resources pursuant to the Georgia Outdoor Stewardship Act, specifically Conserve Georgia Grant Number _____. The Property shall, from this date forward, be managed for conservation purposes in accordance with the conservation objective of the Grant and in compliance with the Georgia Outdoor Stewardship Act. The property shall not be used for purposes inconsistent with the conservation objective of the Grant without the approval and conditions set by Georgia Outdoor Stewardship Trust Fund Board of Trustees.”
