Minutes – Coastal Committee October 22, 2024 Page 2

The October 22, 2024 meeting of the Coastal Resources Committee was called to order by Joe Hatfield, Chairman of the Board of Natural Resources.

Chairman Hatfield called on Nancy Addison, Chair of the Coastal Resources Committee. Ms. Addison called on Karl Burgess, Assistant Director of the Coastal Resources Division.

Mr. Burgess stated that in August, the Coastal Resources Division presented a proposed amendment to the Rules of the Georgia Department of Natural Resources, Saltwater Fishing Regulations, Rule 391-2-4-.11. He further stated the amendment would increase the number of bait minnow traps that a licensed bait dealer may fish at any given time from 10 to 20 but does not increase the total allowable harvest. He added that currently licensed bait dealers are allowed to employ 10 or fewer traps at a given time; the requested change would increase the number of traps employed to 20 while not possessing more than 100 quarts of bait minnows at any time.

Mr. Burgess stated that CRD issued a public notice, press release, and Internet postings and no public comments were received. He further stated that if there no questions he requests favorable consideration.

A motion was made by Mr. Jones, seconded by Mr. Yancey, and carried unanimously that the Committee recommends the Board adopt the resolution to approve the proposed amendment to the Rules of the Georgia Department of Natural Resources, Saltwater Fishing Regulations, Chapter 391-2-4-.11.

There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned.
