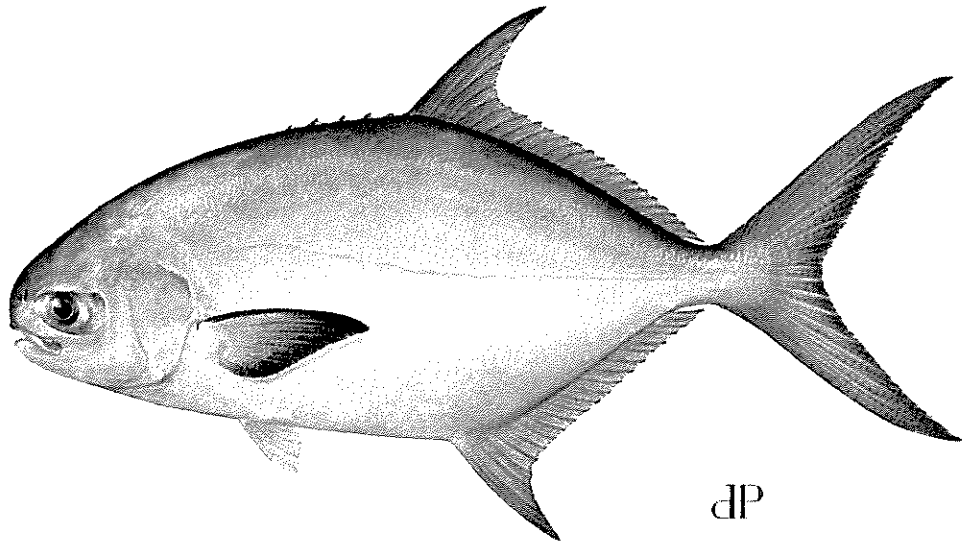
This new record in no way diminishes the excellence of your previous catch. Each record remains a unique and exciting experience for each angler.
