

NEWS RELEASE

February 28, 1983

A Tybee Island resident has set a new record for black sea bass in the women's division in the Georgia Saltwater Gamefish Records program, according to program leader Henry Ansley.

Evelyn B. Carter of Tybee Island caught a 4-pound, 8-ounce fish on January 25, 1983 at the Savannah Snapper Banks while fishing aboard the Saltwater captained by Jack Wiggins. She used squid for bait.

Her catch breaks the former record, which was held by Gwen Ward of Jesup for a 3-pound, 5-ounce black sea bass caught in April of 1981 at Gray's Reef.

The Georgia Saltwater Gamefish Records program is administered through the Coastal Resources Division of the Department of Natural Resources. Anglers landing potential state record fish should contact Coastal Resources Division offices in Brunswick. Claims for record fish must be submitted within 30 days of the catch. The fish has to be weighed on a certified scale and a photograph of the angler and the fish must accompany the application.
