The following action was taken at the January 12, 2021 Georgia Outdoor Stewardship Trust Fund Board of Trustees Meeting:

Chairman Mark Williams called the meeting to order.

The Board approved the minutes of the October 13, 2020 Board of Trustees meeting.

Chairman Williams gave opening remarks.

Chairman Williams introduced a new member of the Board of Trustees, Tim Lowrimore, State Forester and Director of the Georgia Forestry Commission.

Chairman Williams gave an overview of the 2020-2021 GOSP grant cycle.

Chairman Williams called on Rob Stokes, Georgia Outdoor Stewardship Program (GOSP) Coordinator, to present the 2020-2021 grant cycle Pre-applications results and Proposal of Approved Conservation Projects.

Mr. Stokes presented his report and overview of the 2020-2021 GOSP Pre-application cycle results, and Proposal of Approved Conservation Projects.

Chairman Williams called for questions.

Mr. Boardman asked about the process of reviewing the Pre-applications.

Mr. Stokes stated reviewers review the Pre-applications independently and the system averages the individual scores.

Mr. Canon asked if the GOSP funding amount will cover the proposal of approved conservation projects.

Chairman Williams stated the State Legislature is in session and the budget has not been signed.

The Board approved the 2020-2021 GOSP Proposal of Approved Conservation Projects.
