Part-Time/Year-round GIS Property Boundary Technician

Location: Office is at Panola Mountain State Park, Stockbridge, GA. Work area is statewide.

Hours – This job will work 29 hours per week max. Hours would primarily be Monday – Thursday.

Pay – \$15.00/hr. with potential for growth.

Description and breakdown of work for the season: The GIS/Boundary Technician assists the State Parks Surveyor in researching property deeds at county courthouses, pieces together the park boundary using CAD software, assists in finding the corners of the property boundary out in the field, and helps paint and hang signs on the boundary line.

Training – On the job training would include using basic survey tools and techniques, GIS software, orienteering with a compass and handheld GPS unit. Additional training may include ATV and chainsaw training.

Vehicle – a state vehicle is provided.

Requirements - A completed college degree is not required. Areas of study that would be most appropriate include surveying, mapping, and GIS or QGIS-related topics. Previous experience in a related field is also desirable, but not a requirement. Also, individuals with previous military or public service experience may be well-suited for this position. Applicants should have strong communication skills, be able to work independently and travel extensively in GA, and enjoy working outdoors.
