LET'S CAMP!

Whether you're piloting a 40-foot motorhome or packing a four-pound tent, we have a campsite for you. All of our campgrounds have water and electric hookups, and some offer sewage hookups as well. Central bathhouses provide hot showers and flush toilets in all regular campgrounds. Leashed pets are welcome. You can even make site-specific reservations at select Georgia State Parks.

TENT/TRAILER/RV CAMPSITES

These developed sites offer electrical and water hookups, grills or fire rings, and picnic tables. Some are specially designed just for tents, while others have curved pull-through sites for large RVs. Modern comfort stations with hot showers, flush toilets and electrical outlets are conveniently located. All campgrounds have dump stations and several offer full sewage hook-ups. Wifi and cable are available at some parks. Site-specific reservations are available at Amicalola Falls, James H. Floyd, Reed Bingham, Richard B. Russell and Laura S. Walker state parks.



RV PULL-THROUGHS

Most campgrounds offer some RV sites where campers do not have to back up their rigs. These offer water and electric hookups, dump stations, some sewage hookups.

WALK-IN TENT CAMPSITES

Tent campers will find a bit more privacy and sleep closer to nature at these sites. These wooded campsites provide a tent pad, picnic table and fire ring, but usually no water or electricity. While they are more secluded than tent/trailer/RV sites, they are within easy walking distance of a comfort station, water spigot, trash bins and central parking area.

BACKCOUNTRY CAMPSITES

Backpackers will enjoy the solitude of these undeveloped sites. All camping gear (including water) is packed in and out by the hiker. A few parks, such as Tugaloo and Ft. McAllister, have primitive campsites that do not require a long hike. Even primitive campers can reserve their own spot in advance



EQUESTRIAN

Horse owners will love our campsites and camper cabins that come with horse stalls. Select parks offer equestrian trails and camping facilities.

YURTS – GO GLAMPING!

Luxury-loving guests will enjoy our version of “glamour camping.” Yurts are canvas and wood tents; like a cross between camping and a cabin, with furniture, electricity, and heaters. Grills and picnic tables are located outside. Hot showers are a short walk away. Yurt villages are found only at select Georgia State Parks and pets are not allowed. Browse locations at GaStateParks.org/yurts.

Reservations can be made up to 13 months in advance and are often required on summer or fall weekends. If arriving in less than two days, call the park offices directly to ask about availability and check-on requirements.

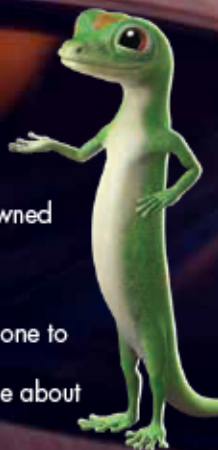
